As is tradition, the Outstanding Judge Award, the Silver Honor Medal and the Outstanding Consulting Rosarian Award were announced for 2006. Buckeye District Judges were the recipients of all three honors. The **Peter and Susan Schneider** were announced the winners of the **Outstanding Judges Award**; **Jerry McCarthy** received the **Silver Honor Medal**; and **Brian Burley** was selected as the **Outstanding Consulting Rosarian**. The Buckeye District currently has a membership of approximately 700 people, but only ten percent of the members attend the spring and fall meetings. It is possible some of our members are not aware of the good things that have recently transpired.

The generosity of the \$86,000 gift to the Buckeye District from the Estate of John and Berdine Walters has greatly enhanced our treasury. The by-laws of the American Rose Society decree the ownership of a District's treasury is the property of the American Rose

Society. However, rather than forfeiting the entire gift a compromise was reached when the Buckeye District gave the American Rose Society \$25,000 to build a walkway from the Klima Center to the chapel.

It is now the responsibility of the District to prudently invest and use the Walter's gift. At our spring meeting in 2006 Terri Lady and our president Jerry Dolph formed a committee consisting of Jeff Sommers, Gary Barlow, Anne Hering, Jim Zimmerman and chaired by Tom Rubins to structure a plan for endowment and use of the \$60,000.

At the recent fall convention the board passed the proposal presented by Tom Rubins for use of the money. He urged the district to allow the money to grow, but the accepted plan allows the district to use the interest for the benefit of Rosarians in Ohio. There is a provision for invasion of the principal at a maximum amount of fifteen percent during the term of a director, but it requires a two third affirmative vote of the membership to pass.

A committee to determine how the money will be invested is chaired by the director and includes the District President, treasurer and two district members appointed by the director. Tom Rubins and Lori Hilfer have accepted these appointments.

The district by-laws that direct the voting procedure of the membership are done through three representatives of each club. The representatives will vote the decision of their club. Caucusing with their members should precede the vote. The local club president will submit the three names to the district secretary at the beginning of each New Year. Additional

information and voting procedure with a copy of the district by-laws will be provided to the president of each club.

Because of the conflicting dates of Palm Sunday, Passover, Good Friday and Easter the first two weeks of April, we are looking for a location in Columbus on April 14 and 15 for the spring meeting. More information will be forthcoming as it is finalized.

It is important to reserve September 22 and 23. These are the dates for the fall rose show and convention. It will be held at the Fellows Riverside Gardens in Youngstown, Ohio and will be hosted by the Mahoning Valley Rose Society.

A place for the 2008 fall convention is needed. Please talk about it and let me know if you can do it.

I feel everyone has a vote and there is merit in every idea. When the ideas are properly sifted and implemented they will benefit the majority of the membership. Please help me by making suggestions.

For the past six years Terri Lady has done an excellent job and spent countless hours working for the benefit of our district. Her efforts are appreciated. Thank you!
