## **From the Director...**

The ARS Vice President Candidates were busy when they visited the Buckeye District. On Saturday afternoon, they served as faculty for the Consulting Rosarian Audit held at Franklin Park Conservatory. Their topics included: Ed Griffith, "Keep it Simple"; George Hartley, Roses A thru Z, "A Walk in our Rose Garden"; Steve Jones, "Floribundas and Polyanthas"; and Jeff Wyckoff, "OGRs in the Modern Garden". Thank you candidates and CR Chair, Steve Pyrak, for a successful and interesting audit.

The following day, we had another full agenda for the candidates at the Buckeye District Spring Meeting. Ed started things off with "The Wonderful World of Roses. Next, George presented "A Walk in the Rose Garden with the Stars". In the afternoon, Steve spoke on "Potpourri of Roses" and Jeff finished up with "Ground Covers or Ground Chuck?". Who better to moderate the panel discussion "The Four Aspiring Directors in Concert" than our own ARS Past President, Dr. Jim Hering. Thank you to everyone who participated in the meeting and especially District President, Jim Zimmerman, and Larry Schock and the members of the Millstream Rose Society for their fund raising efforts.

Ballots were recently mailed for the upcoming triennial election. Remember to vote on the proposed ARS bylaw amendments issue published in the June issue of *American Rose* and for your chosen ARS Vice President candidate.

On Easter weekend, I attended the Spring ARS Convention and Rose Show in New Orleans, LA. At the Board of Director's business meeting a number of items were discussed and approved: 1) A new ARS certificate for "Best In Show" will be available from headquarters for district and local rose shows. 2) The geographical boundary of the South Central District was changed to include the area of Fort Smith, AK. 3) National convention sites of Seattle and Dallas were approved for 2006. Also, the 2004 National Miniature Convention will be hosted in Ft. Worth. 4) John Mattia will serve as guest editor for the 2004 ARS Annual. 5) Finally, the board voted not to renew the contract of Executive Director, Mike Kromer. A search committee was formed to find a new Director. Board members also offered a moment of silence for ARS President Emeritus, Howard Walters. Howard, well known for his dedication to ARS and his popular monthly column, "Rambling Rosarian", passed away on April 14, 2003.

At the awards banquet, Dr. John Dickman received “The Joseph & Marion Klima Medal” for 2003. Established in 1999, the award recognizes excellence in rose education. John’s contributions for the past 30+ years have included author, lecturer, editor and member of national committees dealing with education, publications and research. Congratulations, John, you are indeed a most deserving recipient of this very special award.

The 2002 newsletter/publications awards were recently announced. *The Buckeye Rose Bulletin* received honorable mention and Randy Lady received an Award of Merit for his article, “Are Roses Hard to Grow?”. The ARS 2002 Slide Contest results were also announced. Buckeye District winners included: Deborah Anderson, Randy Lady, David Wisniewski and Rose Marie Wolford. Congratulations to all these talented Buckeye rosarians.

The seventh annual Top Gun meeting will be held on Saturday, August 2, 2003, in Dayton. The meeting is sponsored by the Miami Valley Rose Society and will be held at Wegerzyn Horticultural Center. Our featured speaker will be Jim Mills of K&M Nursery. On Friday night, prior to the meeting, a catered dinner will be held at the home of Jim and Barbara Zimmerman. Be sure to mark the dates September 12-14, 2003 on your calendar. These are the dates for the first ever Buckeye District and Great Lakes District Joint Fall Conference and Rose Show. The Saturday morning combined rose show will feature many classes open to exhibitors from both Districts as well as individual District classes. ## **Buckeye Judges’ Corner**

Congratulations to John Dickman upon receiving the ARS Klima Medal for a lifetime achievement of excellence in rose education. As the Buckeye District Chairman of judges for many years, John set the standard for all other judges, and as a teacher, he is respected, admired and loved by his fellow rosarians. It is heartwarming to see such a fine gentleman honored by this prestigious award. (See Klima Award article in this *Bulletin*.)

I want to thank the 51 (out of 52) Buckeye District judges for submitting their annual report forms for 2002. Now, don’t forget to complete your Roses in Review survey this summer—it is also a requirement of being an accredited judge. Eleven Buckeye judges need to fulfill the four-year seminar (audit) requirement this year to remain accredited. Check the list of judges in this *Bulletin*; if the year in brackets after your name is [2002] or [2003], you are one of the eleven. There will be a horticulture judging seminar at the combined Buckeye /Great Lakes

District convention in Perrysburg on Saturday afternoon, September 13, 2003. The fee for the seminar is five dollars, which goes to your district treasury.

There will also be a two-day horticulture judging school at the district convention. The school will run from 10 am to 5 pm on Saturday, September 13<sup>th</sup>, and from 9 am to Noon on Sunday, the 14<sup>th</sup>. This will allow the judging candidates, as well as the instructors to enter the rose show Saturday morning. There will be a break for lunch and viewing the rose show from 12:30 to 2 pm. The written and practical examinations are Sunday morning. Jon Wier and I are looking for candidates from both the Buckeye and Great Lakes Districts to take the school. The major requirement is that you have been a member of the American Rose Society for the past three years consecutively. The fee for taking the school is fifty dollars (\$50). have six candidates from Buckeye so far and need more.)

The manual for all ARS horticulture judging schools and for all accredited ARS horticulture judges is *Guidelines for Judging Roses*, which was written 42 years ago and has been revised many times since. A complete rewrite of the *Guidelines* has recently been completed by the ARS Horticulture Judging Committee under the direction of Louise Coleman (past chairman) and Ed Griffith (current chairman) and thanks to the Spartan effort of John Dickman who created the format, wrote much of the text and wrote the ideas. This new rewrite will be titled, *Guidelines and Rules for Judging Roses*. It is currently undergoing final review and vote by the ARS Board of Directors and should be available to all ARS members before September. If it is, we will use the new *Guidelines* in the school; if not, we will use the old.

Finally, don't forget to come to the Top Gun meeting in Dayton, August 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup>. Registration form in this *Bulletin*.

## Dr. John Dickman Awarded Klima Medal

At the American Rose Society National Convention in New Orleans, on April 20, 2003, Dr. John Dickman was awarded the Klima Medal by President Tommy Cairns in recognition of "the highest levels of excellence in the field of horticultural education concerning The Rose."

Dr. Dickman has demonstrated a sustained volunteer performance in rose education for the last thirty-six years. His contributions have been made as author of articles on rose culture, lecturer on many rose topics, editor of educational publications, member of national committees dealing with education, publications and research, Buckeye District chairman of

judges for eighteen of the past twenty seven years, and leader and educator in his district and local rose societies.

John is best known to ARS members for his extremely popular monthly columns in *American Rose*, which have run for most of the last twenty-seven years. He is easy to read, and his information is reliable. He authored the "Beginner's Corner" from 1978-1981 and in 1990 and has written the "Q & A Column" from 1992 to present. In 1996 John served as the Guest Editor of *The American Rose Annual*.

Rose education has been John's main interest in the American Rose Society. He has been an active member of the ARS Committee on training and Judging (1980-83), the Publications Committee as Chairman (1983-85), the Editorial Advisory Committee (1997-present) and the Research Committee (2001-present). John is known best in the Buckeye District for the many years he served as Chairman of Horticulture Judges and the outstanding judging schools he conducted. He is highly regarded as a speaker on rose chemicals because of his background in chemistry. For his outstanding contributions as an educator and author, John has received four ARS Presidential Citations and the Buckeye District Director's Award of Merit. Last year, at the ARS National Miniature Rose Conference and Show in Columbus, Dennis Bridges honored John for his service as a rose educator by naming his new mini-flora 'Dr. John Dickman'.

John is the ultimate educator. His entire professional life was devoted to education in chemistry. He earned a Bachelor of Science in education from The Ohio State University followed by a Master's degree and a Ph.D. in Physiological Chemistry, also from O.S.U. His first teaching position was at Urbana High School as an instructor in chemistry, physics and general science. Upon completing his Ph.D., John joined the staff of Chemical Abstracts Service in Columbus, where he was to work for the next thirty years, rising from Assistant Editor in the Biochemistry editorial Department to Senior Editorial Advisor for Editorial Operations. During that period he published nine articles dealing with biochemistry and served as a Consultant to the National Science Foundation and a Teaching Associate at The Ohio State University.

When John retired in 1990, he began writing about his other avocation (in addition to roses), German culinary arts. In 1998 he published *A Taste of Tradition – New Bremen Memories from the Kitchen* and in 2001 *Recipes & Reminiscence – Culinary Memories of a German Heritage*.

Dr. John Dickman is respected and admired by his fellow rosarians for his integrity, his intellectual honesty and his sustained dedication to rose education. He is a most qualified and deserving recipient of the American Rose Society's Klima Medal.

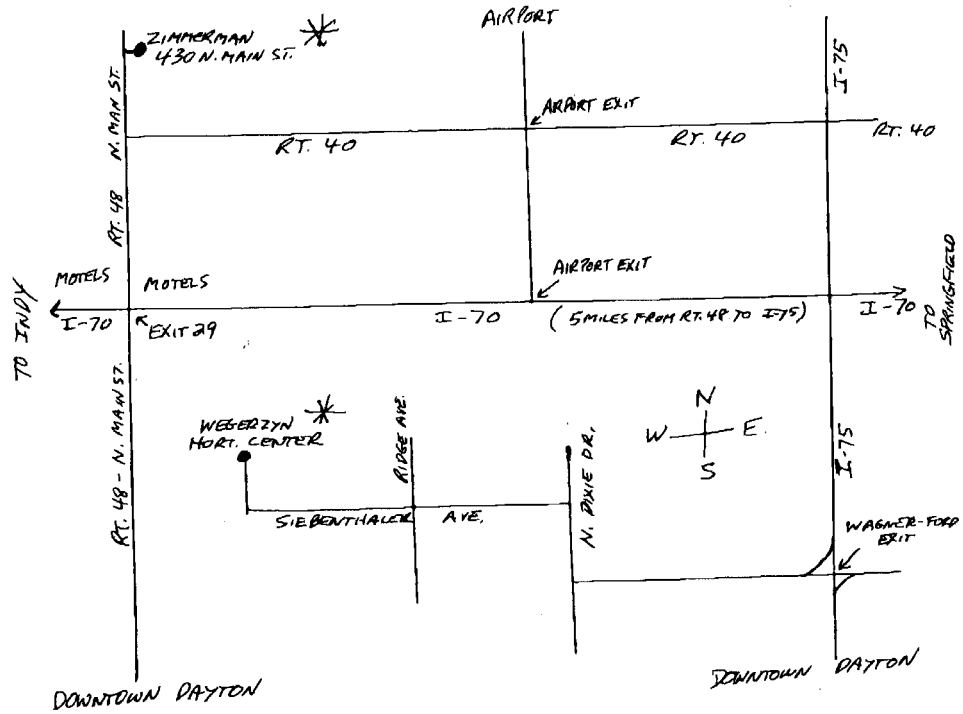
