In addition to the candidates, four Buckeye Accredited Judges attended the school to meet their four year seminar requirement. Revision of ARS Guidelines for Judging Rose Arrangements

By this time, most of you are aware that the draft of the *Arrangement Guidelines* revisions was presented and approved by the ARS Board of Directors, at the Seattle meeting. Thanks to all of you who contributed to our efforts in reaching this point. We are anticipating that the revision of the *Guidelines* will be available for purchase in time for the Fall conference in Dallas. We look forward to having the revised handbook available for you by that time.

The following is a listing of several important changes that are now in effect.

Score Card for Judging Arrangements. The following modified score-card is now the official score card that is to be used for all ARS rose shows. Please note the two numerical changes (highlighted in bold print).

ARS Arrangement Score Card

Conformance (*number change)	15 points
a. Naming of roses	
b. Conformance to type of design	
c. Other specific requirements of the schedule	
Design	30 points
Perfection of the rose(s)	30 points
Creativity & Expressiveness (*number change)	15 points
Distinction	10 points
Total	100 points

New Classes of Designs. Three new special class arrangements were approved. They are:

- 1) Miniature Princess of Arrangements. Similar to standard sized Princess of

Arrangements. Shown as a special class arrangement, with type of design being determined by the exhibitor. ARS Miniature Princess Rosette.

- 2) Miniature Duchess of Arrangements. Similar to standard sized Duchess of Arrangements. Shown as a special class arrangement, with type of design being determined by the exhibitor. ARS Miniature Duchess Rosette.
- 3) Duke of Arrangements. A small arrangement limited to no less than ten (10) inches and no greater than twenty (20) inches in height, width and depth. Any type of rose may be used in the arrangement. Shown as a special class arrangement, with type of design being determined by the exhibitor. ARS Duke of Arrangements Rosette.

Personal Adornment Classes. The chapter on corsages, boutonnieres, chaplets, lapels and nosegays has been modified to be a personal adornment chapter. The *Personal Adornment* chapter includes those exhibits that contain fresh roses and are worn, carried or used by a person: boutonnieres, bridal flowers, chaplets, corsages and hats. ARS Personal Adornments Certificate.

Arrangements in the Oriental Manner Chapter. The chapter for Oriental designs (in the Oriental manner) has been shortened. It was interesting to receive all of the input for modifying this chapter. Some of the input suggested that there was too much content; others thought the content was sufficient; and still others wanted to have more information about Oriental designs. To respond specifically to those persons wanting additional information about Oriental arrangements, we are exploring the establishment of a focus group within the ARS for those persons who want to learn more about this style of design. Please let me know if

you are interested in being a part of such a focus group, and also if you are currently a member of

Ikebana International.

Plan for the Buckeye District Endowment Fund

This is at present only a plan for the Endowment Fund. With approval, it may be converted to a set of By-Laws relative to the Endowment Fund and has been written in such a way that it may be converted to By-Laws

The fund will be known as the John and Berdine Walter's Endowment Fund; however it will be referred to as 'The Endowment Fund'.

The purpose of the fund is to provide financial support to:

- a. Educate the membership and the general public in the most up-to-date horticultural methods of rose growing,
- b. Promote the Rose as a symbol of love, peace, beauty and friendship and encourage rose gardening as an enjoyable hobby,
- c. Support the American Rose Society in its work as a conservation, preservation and research organization dedicated to roses,
- d. Encourage membership in the American Rose Society as dedicated to rose horticulture and its purpose to aid amateur, expert and hobbyists in growing roses

The Endowment fund will be administrated by a committee of five (5) people chaired by the District Director and including the District Treasurer, the District President, and two people appointed by the District Director. The appointees will serve a term of three years and may be appointed for a second term. The terms are to coincide with the term of the District Director.

The District Treasurer will report on the status of the fund at each district meeting and also will provide all necessary reports for tax purposes. The use of a Lawyer or CPA for these purposes is an approved expenditure from the endowment

funds. These reports will be approved by the Endowment Committee prior to presentation at the meeting

The Endowment Committee will meet at each District meeting and at such other times as required. The Endowment Committee will review any requests for expenditure of funds and make recommendations to the membership at the Spring District Meeting. They will also coordinate the investment of the Endowment funds. It is recommended that actual investment be done by an investment professional. Additional funds may, as they become available, be invested in the Endowment Fund.

The portion of the annual earnings (including net income and net appreciation) may be allocated as available annually for distribution in accordance with the purpose of the Endowment Fund. This allocation will be recommended by the Endowment Committee and approved by the voting membership at the spring meeting each year.

Any invasion of the principal is limited to no more than 15 % total during a three year term, with the amount determined at the start of the term. An invasion of the principal must be approved by the Endowment Committee and presented to the membership. A 67% vote of the membership is required for the principle invasion.

Any suggestion or request for expenditure of Endowment funds, either net income or invasion of principle, shall be provided to the District Director 45 days prior to the spring meeting. This request shall include information that will define how the expenditure fits with the purpose of the endowment fund, how much funds are requested and from where, and any other information that will allow the Endowment Committee to make a determination concerning

the request. The Director will distribute it to the Endowment Committee and with approval, will distribute same to all local societies 30 days before the spring meeting. This will allow local societies to discuss during their meeting prior to the vote at the spring meeting.

It is important that the Endowment Fund be used where it will benefit members of the Buckeye District. Also it should be considered that the Fund be allowed to grow for several years to assure availability for future generations.
