Generosa – old-world shrubs created by Guillot, the oldest rose form in France

Palace – roses for containers and small spaces

Renaissance – fragrant and disease-resistant line of shrub roses from Poulsen

Town & Country – hardy, own root landscape roses – groundcovers to Mounding shrubs.

Antique Roses – roses from the 17th and 18th centuries

Climbers & Ramblers – roses for pillars, arbors and trees
